Each Classroom Visit is designed to cover one or more of the topics below. Each topic includes its own curriculum. Curriculum is adjusted based on the grade level of students. Classroom Visits last 30 - 60 minutes and can be customized. You will work directly with our Public Educator to create the best experience for your unique students.

CLASSROOM VISIT TOPICS:

Exit Drills in The Home

- Students will be able to identify what do in the event on a home fire as well as learning the importance of a home fire escape plan.

• Crawl Low Under Smoke

- Students will be able to identify a smoke alarm both visually and by the sound it makes
- Students will demonstrate what to do when the smoke alarm sounds.

• Calling 9-1-1

- Students will learn when they should call 9-1-1
- Students will be able to determine what's an emergency/what's not
- Students will demonstrate dialing 9-1-1 using a practice phone.

Matches/Lighter Safety

- Students will learn that matches and lighters can get hot and hurt children
- Students will learn to tell a grown-up immediately if they find either tools.
- Students will be able to identify hot things that can hurt and to not touch them.

• Firefighters Are Our Friends

- Students will learn the type of special gear firefighters wear to protect them from fire and smoke.
- Students will recognize that a firefighter is a friendly person who helps protect the community

Tools or Toys

- Students will be able to identify tools that adults use
- Students will be able to recognize toys that are safe for them to play with

• Stop! Drop! And Roll!

- To educate students on what to do if fire should ever get on his/her clothes. Be able to demonstrate stop! Drop! And roll!

• Poison Prevention

- Students will be able to recognize items that are not edible and dangerous.
