MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MOU IS BETWEEN THE RENTON REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY AND KING COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT #40 AND PERTAINS TO THE ALLOCATION OF AMBULANCE TRANSPORT REVENUES

WHEREAS, both parties hereto are municipal corporations pursuant to Title 52 RCW and are executing this MOU pursuant to their authority under Title 52 RCW;

WHEREAS, the Renton Regional Fire Authority ("RRFA") is a fee for service ambulance transport provider;

WHEREAS, the RRFA will be applying under RCW 41.05.730 for Ground Emergency Medical Transportation ("GEMT");

WHEREAS, the RRFA provides fire protection and emergency medical services to King County Fire Protection District No. 40 ("KCFD40") and the citizens within the boundaries of KCFD40;

WHEREAS, the RRFA may receive fees for transports and GEMT reimbursement for transports using aid car A317, which is primarily stationed at KCFD40's Station 17 ("KCFD40 Transports");

WHEREAS, the RRFA may receive fees for transports and GEMT reimbursement for transports using aid cars other than A317, which may respond into KCFD40 but such transports shall not be considered KCFD40 Transports;

WHEREAS, the RRFA shall assess and collect transport fees and GEMT payments pursuant to the RRFA's National Provider Identifier and in accordance with RRFA policy; and

WHEREAS, the Parties agree that KCFD40, by virtue of providing an additional patient base to the RRFA, should receive an equitable share of fees and GEMT payments received by the RRFA as a result of KCFD40 Transports.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. The RRFA shall account for all KCFD40 Transports performed by the RRFA;
- 2. The RRFA shall, on a semi-annual basis each May 1 and November 1, apply a credit to KCFD40's semi-annual contract payments in an amount equal to the funds received by the RRFA prior to the payment dates for KCFD40 Transports;
- 3. The Parties may incorporate this Agreement into any future Fire and Emergency Services Operating Agreement between the Parties, and may amend this Agreement to establish the exact allocation of GEMT funds to KCFD40 as a result of KCFD40 Transports performed by the RRFA; and

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4. This MOU may be terminated by either party upon six month's written notice.
