Included in the approved 2024 capital fleet budget is a water rescue team boat. The SJX2170 rescue boat is a unique apparatus that meets the specific needs of the water rescue team. No other boat on the market offers the required specifications, and only SJX sells it. This resolution is to approve a waiver of competitive bidding requirements according to RCW 39.04.280.

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-01 WAIVER OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS SOLE SOURCE WATER RESCUE BOAT

WHEREAS, RCW 39.04.280 provides for the waiver of competitive bidding requirements under enumerated conditions including (1)(a) Purchases that are clearly and legitimately limited to a single source of supply and (1)(b) Purchases involving special facilities or market conditions; and

WHEREAS, Renton Regional Fire Authority (RFA) is in need of a Water Rescue Boat; and

WHEREAS, Renton RFA staff have determined that boat designs with standard inboard or outboard marine motors will not operate effectively in the RRFA's service area which predominantly consists of swift and shallow river conditions and have identified a specific boat design that will meet the needs of the RRFA "Rescue Boat" as noted in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, after a diligent search, Renton RFA staff have determined that the specification for the Rescue Boat that meets the Renton RFA needs including a highly customized hull and power train is only available from one manufacturer, SJX Boats, who can build to this specification and deliver the unit in a reasonable timeframe as noted in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, SJX Boats can build the Rescue Boat for a cost of \$107,957.00 plus applicable tax and licensing. Renton RFA staff believe that the cost of the Rescue Boat is reasonable; and

WHEREAS, Renton RFA staff has determined that no other vendor can build or provide the Rescue Boat in a timely manner and that given the current supply chain issues, has determined that SJX is the only vendor that can provide the Rescue Boat and, under current market conditions is clearly and legitimately the sole source of supply for the Rescue Boat as noted in Exhibit B;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Governing Board of the Renton Regional Fire Authority hereby declares a sole source and special market condition and waives the competitive bidding requirements for the reasons enumerated above and approves the sole source purchase of a 2024 SJX2170 Water Rescue Boat in the amount of \$107,957.00 plus applicable tax and licensing.

Sole Source Justification

To Whom It May Concern,

Renton Regional Fire Authority (RRFA) is requesting a sole source approval and waiver of bidding requirements for the purchase of a water rescue team boat. The water rescue team developed specific specifications for the needs required by their team functions. It has been found that only one vendor makes such a boat and that they are also the only vendor who sells it. It is futile to go out to bid knowing that no other vendor can meet the requirements.

SJX Jetboats produces a watercraft that is unique in the industry and fulfils the specifications of the RRFA water rescue team. SJX has provided a document that details their unique features and that they are the sole source. In addition to this, I have communicated with the water rescue team lead and learned the specific needs they have that SJX can provide and which no other vendor can.

Our team leader has done research on vendors, has experience with many years on the team, and is also a rescue boat operator instructor. He has stated that the SJX has a unique platform that is required by the team. The SJX boat is the only one that has the ability to operate in shallow water and has the construction materials to prevent damage to the hull while doing so. It is also the only boat with the ability to give a large enough and stable platform to conduct lifesaving efforts such as CPR. The specific features allow the team to respond to any environment they may be called to assist from lake to Puget Sound to flood conditions. This is also the only boat that can provide the team access to any lake front or river areas in our response district.

For these reasons the SJX Jetboat meets the requirement for sole sourcing, meeting the requirements of the only boat that fills the needs of the water rescue team, a unique boat that no other vendor makes, and a sole vendor that sells such a boat.

The RRFA will require two new ladders in 2029. One to replace the aging back up and a second to address high-rise growth throughout the Renton RFA response area. Funds are accounted for in the Fleet Capital account. RRFA finance staff have evaluated the savings offered for a pre-payment vs. the anticipated interest revenue from not pre-paying for both ladders, based on an average interest rate received through the KC investment pool. There is less than a \$10,000 cost savings. The finance team recommends not pre-paying. Note: This is currently under review by Legal.
