Chief Construction Bid Approval for Station 16

RRFA received four cost estimates for the construction of the new Station 16 and maintenance building project. To keep the construction project on schedule, the RFA requested the board grant Chief Heitman the authority to approve a construction bid proposal not to exceed \$33 million.
